12 over 15 years of service to Elmore County at the Highway  
13 Department as a subdivision inspector and later worked as a  
14 County Commission License Inspector; and

15 WHEREAS, Trey Taylor was elected to the Elmore  
16 County Commission to represent District 2 in November 2012;  
17 and

18 WHEREAS, Commissioner Taylor and members of the  
19 current commission have expanded the Countywide Cleanup Days  
20 to include additional dates and locations, implemented a  
21 Countywide Shred Event, and passed a dog containment law; and

22 WHEREAS, seeing the necessity for a long-term plan  
23 for the county's roads and infrastructures, the current county  
24 commission has adopted the Blueprint 2020 Plan which includes  
25 improvements to over 165 miles of county roads, three bridge  
26 replacements, an energy savings program for county facilities,

1 and improvements to or construction of multiple county  
2 facilities; and

3 WHEREAS, Commissioner Taylor was appointed to serve  
4 on the Alabama Association of County Commissioners Legislative  
5 Committee; and

6 WHEREAS, Commissioner Taylor is known for attending  
7 neighborhood meetings and looking out for the best interest of  
8 the citizens of District 2; and

9 WHEREAS, Trey Taylor is a lifetime resident of  
10 Elmore County, a 1985 graduate of Tallassee High School, and a  
11 2009 graduate of Auburn University Montgomery; and

12 WHEREAS, Trey Taylor is a faithful member of  
13 Rushenville Baptist Church where he serves as a Deacon; and

14 WHEREAS, Trey Taylor is devoted to his wife Holley,  
15 and his two children, Madeline and Jase; now therefore,
