15	primarily to destroy the credibility of innocent persons if
16	the existence of a complaint becomes known to the public
17	before it has been properly investigated; and
18	WHEREAS, with regard to confidentiality, Section
19	36-25-4.1 of the Code of Alabama 1975, provides in pertinent
20	part: " no complaints shall be made available to the public
21	or available on the Internet until the disposition of the
22	matter. In no event may a complaint be made public or
23	available on the Internet if the complaint is dismissed or
24	found not to have probable cause. In the matters where the

complaint is dismissed or found not to have probable cause,

only the disposition of the matter may be made available to the public or available on the Internet."; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That, in order to protect the credibility of innocent persons from groundless complaint, a Joint Legislative Committee is created to investigate confidentiality issues involved with complaints filed with the State Ethics Commission.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the committee shall be comprised of three members of the Senate chosen by the Lieutenant Governor and three members of the House of Representatives chosen by the Speaker of the House.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That each member of the committee shall be entitled to his or her per diem and travel expenses for each day he or she attends a meeting of the committee.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the committee shall report its findings and recommendations to the Legislature by the fifth day of the 2017 Regular Session of the Legislature.
