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9 A BILL
10 TO BE ENTITLED
11 AN ACT
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13 To alter or rearrange the boundary lines of the Town
14 of Union, Greene County, Alabama, so as to include within the
15 corporate limits of said Town all territory now within such
16 corporate limits and also certain other territory contiguous
17 thereto, in Union, Greene County, Alabama.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

19 Section 1. The boundary lines of the Town of Union,
20 Greene County, Alabama, be, and the same are hereby altered or
21 rearranged so as to include all of the territory heretofore
22 encompassed by the corporate limits of the Town of Union, and
23 in addition thereto the following described territory, to wit:

24 Tract No. 1 as shown in Exhibit A and described as:
25 All of the NE1/4 of the NW1/4 of Section 4, Township 23 North,
26 Range 2 East that is located north of County Highway 191.

1 Tract No. 2 as shown in Exhibit A and described as:
2 The E1/2 of the SE1/4 of the NE1/4 of Section 5, Township 23
3 North, Range 2 East.

4 Tract No. 3 as shown in Exhibit A and described as:
5 The W1/2 of the W1/2 of the SW1/4 of Section 4, Township 23
6 North, Range 2 East.

7 Tract No. 4 as shown in Exhibit A and described as:
8 A certain tract or parcel of land in the N1/2 of Section 8,
9 Township 23 North, Range 2 East, more particularly described
10 as follows: Begin at the intersection of the Union-Mantua Road
11 and the Union-Snoddy Road; then run in a northeasterly
12 direction along the east margin of the Union-Snoddy Road for a
13 distance of 300 yards, more or less, to a guy pole; then
14 continue in the same direction for a distance of 6 yards to
15 the point of beginning of the tract of parcel of land herein
16 conveyed; then continue in a northeasterly direction along the
17 east margin of the Union-Snoddy Road for a distance of 180
18 yards; then run in a southeasterly direction at right angles
19 to said road for a distance of 64 yards; then run in a
20 southwesterly direction and parallel to said road for a
21 distance of 120 yards; then run in a westerly direction to the
22 point of beginning.

23 Tract No. 5 as shown in Exhibit A and described as:
24 A certain tract or parcel of land in the N1/2 of Section 8,
25 Township 23 North, Range 2 East. Begin at the intersection of
26 the Union-Mantua and the Union-Snoddy Roads; thence run in a
27 northeasterly direction along the East margin of the

1 Union-Snoddy Road for a distance of 300 yards, more or less,
2 to a guy pole, thence continue in the same direction for a
3 distance of 186 yards to the point of beginning of the herein
4 described lot; thence run in a Southeasterly direction at
5 right angles to said road for a distance of 210 feet; thence
6 run in a Southwesterly direction and parallel to said road for
7 a distance of 105 feet; thence run in a Northwesterly
8 direction a distance of 210 feet to the East margin of the
9 Union-Snoddy Road; thence run in a Northeasterly direction
10 along the East margin of the Union-Snoddy Road a distance of
11 105 feet to the point of beginning.

12 Tract No. 6 as shown in Exhibit A and described as:
13 A certain tract or parcel of land in the N1/2 of Section 8,
14 Township 23 North, Range 2 East. Begin at a point on the east
15 margin of the right-of-way of the new Union Snoddy Road which
16 is the northwest corner of the two-acre tract conveyed by Alma
17 M. Friday and Earnest Friday to President Fulgham and
18 Christine Fulgham on May 5, 1959, in Deed Book No. 54, page
19 516; thence run in a northeasterly direction along the east
20 margin of the right-of-way of said road for 76 yards, thence
21 run in a southeasterly direction at right angles to said road
22 for 128 yards, thence run in a southwesterly direction and
23 parallel to said road for 128 yards to the point of beginning

24 Section 2. A map showing the proposed territory to
25 be annexed is on file in the office of the judge of probate in
26 Greene County, Alabama. This map is open to public inspection.

1 Section 3. This act shall become effective upon its
2 passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise
3 becoming law.
