13 Relating to Cullman County; to provide for an
14 advisory referendum on the November 2016 General Election
15 ballot on whether the office of Cullman County Superintendent
16 of Education should be changed from an appointed position to
17 an elected position.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

19 Section 1. (a) An advisory referendum shall be
20 included on the November 2016 General Election ballot in
21 Cullman County on whether a majority of the electors in the
22 county, who are not residents of a city in the county which
23 has a separate school system, are in favor of changing the
24 office of Cullman County Superintendent of Education from an
25 appointed position to an elected position.

26 (b) The appropriate election official shall set
27 forth the question to be voted on substantially as follows:

1 "Do you favor the election of the Cullman County
2 Superintendent of Education by the qualified electors of the
3 county who are not electors of a city in the county which has
4 a separate city school system?

5 Yes () No ()."

6 Section 2. This act shall become effective
7 immediately following its passage and approval by the
8 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
