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8 SYNOPSIS: Existing law does not specifically prohibit
9 an agency of the state that receives appropriations
10 from the General Fund or the Education Trust Fund
11 from entering into or renewing a contract with a
12 lobbyist for lobbying.

13 This bill would prohibit an agency of the
14 Executive Department of the state that receives
15 appropriations from the General Fund or the
16 Education Trust Fund from entering into or renewing
17 a contract with a lobbyist for lobbying.

23 Relating to lobbying; to prohibit an agency of the
24 Executive Department of the state that receives appropriations
25 from the General Fund or the Education Trust Fund from
26 entering into or renewing a contract with a lobbyist for
27 lobbying.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

2 Section 1. On and after the effective date of this
3 act, an agency of the Executive Department of the state that
4 receives appropriations from the General Fund or the Education
5 Trust Fund may not enter into or renew a contract with a
6 lobbyist for lobbying as those terms are defined in Section
7 36-25-1, Code of Alabama 1975.

8 Section 2. This act shall become effective
9 immediately following its passage and approval by the
10 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
