WHEREAS, the committee has a responsibility to ensure that the department operates as effectively and efficiently as possible with the resources it has been given; and

WHEREAS, the National Conference of State

Legislatures (NCSL) has performed numerous legislative studies

and organizational reviews in Alabama and other states; and

WHEREAS, legislative leadership in both the House of Representatives and the Senate has reached out to NCSL about performing an organizational review of the Department; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That in support of the request of the Joint Legislative Committee on Public Accounts, we request NCSL to conduct an organizational review of the Department of Examiners of Public Accounts, including a comparison of similar operations and best practices in other states and a review of the management practices, operations, procedures, and structure of the department to improve its effectiveness, accountability, and transparency.
