WHEREAS, naming a bridge for the veterans of Vietnam would serve as a lasting memorial to the historical legacy and dedication of these brave men and women who are deserving of our support, recognition, and honor; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That in honor of the Alabama veterans of Vietnam, we declare the Southside Bridge in Etowah County be named the Vietnam Veterans Memorial Bridge.
