S. Armed Forces lost 21 their lives in Vietnam; and 22 WHEREAS, naming a bridge for the veterans of Vietnam 23 would serve as a lasting memorial to the historical legacy and 24 dedication of these brave men and women who are deserving of 25 our support, recognition, and honor; now therefore,

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BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That in honor of the Alabama veterans of Vietnam, we declare the Southside Bridge in Etowah County be named the Vietnam Veterans Memorial Bridge.
