1 WHEREAS, though the exact cause of sarcoidosis is 2 not known, current research indicates that in individuals who 3 are genetically susceptible to sarcoidosis, exposure to 4 bacteria, viruses or chemicals might trigger the disease; and

5 WHEREAS, while progress has been made in 6 understanding the symptoms and better diagnosing the disease, 7 there is still much to learn about sarcoidosis, but with 8 increased research, the goal of discovering the cause, 9 improving treatment and finding a cure is attainable; now 10 therefore,
