26 any legislative session; and

1 WHEREAS, in order to reestablish the general 2 public's trust and confidence in elected officials in Alabama, 3 it is necessary for the Legislature to go on record as 4 prohibiting the solicitation of funds for campaign finances or 5 legal defense during sessions of the Legislature; now 6 therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That we hereby express our resolve to refrain from the solicitation of campaign funding and legal defense funding, and to decline acceptance of any such funding during any legislative session in Alabama during 2016.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That we request the House and Senate to each adopt this resolution pursuant to a roll call vote.
