18	as aware of the requirement as they should be; and
19	WHEREAS, the Legislature continues to believe that
20	the filing of the Statement of Economic Interests is a
21	valuable tool in preventing abuse, providing integrity, and
22	promoting public confidence in state and local government; now
23	therefore,
24	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
25	HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That we hereby urge the State
26	Ethics Commission to better communicate the need for filing of
27	Statements of Economic Interests to the executive directors

and chairs of boards where the board members are
non-compensated appointees and implement a system to have
those executive directors and chairs communicate the filing
requirements with their respective board members.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That a copy of this
resolution be provided to the Executive Director of the State
Ethics Commission, as an expression of the sentiment of the

Legislature.
