8 SYNOPSIS: Under existing law, termination dates are
9 established for enumerated state agencies. The
10 agencies are periodically reviewed by the Alabama
11 Sunset Committee. After the review process is
12 completed, the committee prepares its
13 recommendations for the agencies to the Legislature
14 in the form of sunset bills which either continue,
15 terminate, or continue with modification each
16 agency reviewed.

17 This bill would provide for the continuance
18 of the Board of Boilers and Pressure Vessels, with
19 the following change: To remove the board from the
20 sunset review process.

26 Relating to the Alabama Sunset Law; to continue the
27 existence and functioning of the Board of Boilers and Pressure

1 Vessels with certain modifications; to repeal Section
2 25-12-22, Code of Alabama 1975, so as to remove the board from
3 the sunset review process.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

5 Section 1. Pursuant to the Alabama Sunset Law, the
6 Sunset Committee recommends the continuance of the Board of
7 Boilers and Pressure Vessels, with the additional
8 recommendation for statutory change as set out in Section 3.

9 Section 2. The existence and functioning of the
10 Board of Boilers and Pressure Vessels, created and functioning
11 pursuant to Sections 25-12-1 to 25-12-21, inclusive, Code of
12 Alabama 1975, is continued, and those code sections are
13 expressly preserved.

14 Section 3. Section 25-12-22, Code of Alabama 1975,
15 subjecting the Board of Boilers and Pressure Vessels to review
16 under the Alabama Sunset Law, is repealed.

17 Section 4. The Legislature concurs in the
18 recommendations of the Sunset Committee as provided in
19 Sections 1, 2, and 3.

20 Section 5. This act shall become effective
21 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or
22 its otherwise becoming law.
