BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. No person may be elected or appointed for more than three full consecutive terms of office to any board, commission, department, or public office that receives state funding. An election or appointment to fill a vacant position for an unexpired term of office that is one-half or longer of the original term is a full term in the respective body.

Section 2. Any person serving a term of office as of the effective date of this act that would otherwise exceed the limitations imposed by Section 1 shall continue to serve until the end of the term for which he or she was elected or appointed.

Section 3. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
