8 SYNOPSIS: Under existing law, the Alabama State Law
9 Enforcement Agency must make available to any
10 resident of this state who does not hold a valid
11 Alabama driver's license a nondriver identification
12 card to be used for identification purposes only.

13 This bill would give the Commissioner of the
14 Department of Corrections, in coordination with the
15 Secretary of the Alabama State Law Enforcement
16 Agency, the authority to establish a program to
17 issue a nondriver identification card to a resident
18 parolee upon his or her release from prison.

24 Relating to nondriver identification cards and
25 parolees; to give the Commissioner of the Department of
26 Corrections, in coordination with the Secretary of the Alabama
27 State Law Enforcement Agency, the authority to establish a

1 program to issue a nondriver identification card to a resident
2 parolee upon his or her release from prison.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

4 Section 1. The Commissioner of the Department of
5 Corrections, in coordination with the Secretary of the Alabama
6 State Law Enforcement Agency, shall have the authority to
7 promulgate rules to establish a program by January 1 of the
8 year following the effective date of this act to issue a
9 nondriver identification card to a resident parolee upon his
10 or her release from prison.

11 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
12 first day of the third month following its passage and
13 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
