Section 1. The Commissioner of the Department of Corrections, in coordination with the Secretary of the Alabama State Law Enforcement Agency, shall have the authority to promulgate rules to establish a program by January 1 of the year following the effective date of this act to issue a nondriver identification card to a resident parolee upon his or her release from prison.

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
