A BILL  
TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

                         Relating to municipalities; to provide further for  
the procedure for a municipal governing body to adopt a  
salary, expense allowance, or other compensation increase.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

                         Section 1. (a) The salary, expense allowance, or  
other compensation of the members of the municipal governing  
body of any municipality may not be increased by the municipal  
governing body unless the proposed ordinance or resolution of  
the municipal governing body was introduced at regular  
meetings of the municipal governing body not less than 30 days  
prior to the meeting at which the ordinance is adopted.



1           (b) In addition to the requirements of subsection  
2 (a), the proposed ordinance or resolution shall be published  
3 in the same manner as required for an ordinance pursuant to  
4 subsection (b) of Section 11-45-8, Code of Alabama 1975,  
5 within seven business days after it is proposed.

6           (c) This act shall apply to all municipalities in  
7 this state including municipalities in Classes 1 to 8,  
8 inclusive, and any municipalities provided by any other  
9 general law, local law, or general law of local application,  
10 and any law in conflict with this act is repealed and  
11 superseded.

12           (d) If any salary or expense allowance increase was  
13 adopted by a municipal governing body prior to the effective  
14 date of this act, the salary or expense allowance may only be  
15 operative if the ordinance or resolution providing for the  
16 increase is readopted pursuant to the requirements of this act  
17 which readoption may be enacted at any time prior to the new  
18 municipal governing body taking office. To the extent this  
19 subsection conflicts with any other law, this subsection shall  
20 supersede the other law.

21           (e) This act shall not apply to the office of mayor  
22 of a municipality unless the mayor sits as a member of the  
23 council or other municipal governing body.

24           Section 2. All laws or parts of laws which conflict  
25 with this act are repealed.



BILL STATUS

1                   Section 3. This act shall become effective  
2 immediately following its passage and approval by the  
3 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
