1 SJR38 2 3 4 ENROLLED, SJR38, 5 URGING THE GOVERNOR TO ESTABLISH THE ALABAMA 6 COMMISSION ON RAILWAY SAFETY. 7 8 WHEREAS, the Legislature is committed to the 9 protection and well-being of all citizens of this state; and 10 WHEREAS, a safe and efficient railway system is 11 vital for businesses and industries currently operating in 12 this state and for future economic development in this state; 13 and 14 WHEREAS, the Legislature recognizes that the 15 operation of the rail transportation system supports millions 16 of jobs and generates billions of dollars over the years in 17 the national economy; and 18 WHEREAS, railroad operations that routinely block 19 highway and road crossings present public safety, 20 transportation, and other critical issues for municipal and 21 county governments across the state; and WHEREAS, solutions that enhance the safety of 22 23 railroad operations in this state benefit both the general 24 public and railroad employees; and

1 WHEREAS, it is imperative to study the current 2 operation of the rail transportation system and highway 3 traffic flow in this state to identify areas of risk to public 4 safety and advance proven and innovative technologies and 5 procedures to promote public railway safety; now therefore,

6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH 7 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That the Governor of the State of 8 Alabama is urged to create an Alabama Commission on Railway 9 Safety comprised of up to 17 members to conduct a review of 10 the current railroad safety laws, regulations, and procedures 11 in this state and recommend improvements, including 12 implementing innovative technology, improving highway traffic 13 flow and grade separation, closing redundant grade crossings, and increasing funding for Alabama Department of 14 15 Transportation's Section 130 Program, among other possible ideas to promote and enhance public railway safety in this 16 17 state.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That membership of the Alabama Commission On Railway Safety be comprised of the following:

(1) The President of the Public Service Commission,
or his or her designee.

(2) The Director of the Alabama Department of
 Transportation, or his or her designee.

(3) The Director of the Alabama Emergency Management Agency, or his or her designee.

(12) The Executive Director of Operation 4 5 Lifesaver-Alabama, or his or her designee. 6 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That all state agencies are urged to cooperate fully with the commission in accomplishing 7 the objectives of the commission, and that a copy of this 8 9 resolution be presented to the Governor so that our sincere 10 and continuing interest in this matter is known.
