1 WHEREAS, it is imperative to study the current 2 operation of the rail transportation system and highway 3 traffic flow in this state to identify areas of risk to public 4 safety and advance proven and innovative technologies and 5 procedures to promote public railway safety; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH 6 7 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That the Governor of the State of Alabama is urged to create an Alabama Commission on Railway 8 Safety comprised of up to 17 members to conduct a review of 9 10 the current railroad safety laws, regulations, and procedures 11 in this state and recommend improvements, including 12 implementing innovative technology, improving highway traffic 13 flow and grade separation, closing redundant grade crossings, and increasing funding for Alabama Department of 14 Transportation's Section 130 Program, among other possible 15 16 ideas to promote and enhance public railway safety in this 17 state.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That membership of the Alabama Commission On Railway Safety be comprised of the following:

(1) The President of the Public Service Commission,
or his or her designee.

(2) The Director of the Alabama Department of
 Transportation, or his or her designee.

(3) The Director of the Alabama Emergency Management
 Agency, or his or her designee.

(4) The Secretary of the Alabama Law Enforcement
 Agency, or his or her designee.

3 (5) The Alabama State Fire Marshal, or his or her4 designee.

5 (6) The President of the Alabama Sheriff's 6 Association, or his or her designee, may appoint a maximum of 7 two sworn law enforcement officers currently working in an 8 area with rail grades and crossings in their jurisdictions.

9 (7) The President of the Alabama Association of 10 Chiefs of Police, or his or her designee, may appoint a 11 maximum of two sworn law enforcement officers currently 12 working in an area with rail grades and crossings in their 13 jurisdictions.

14 (8) The President of the Alabama Firefighters
15 Association, or his or her designee, may appoint a maximum of
16 two firefighters currently working in an area with rail grades
17 and crossings in their jurisdictions.

18 (9) The General Counsel for the Alabama League of19 Municipalities, or his or her designee.

(10) The Executive Director of the Association of
 County Commissioners of Alabama, or his or her designee.

(11) Three members appointed by the Governor, two
 representing the railroad industry and one representing the
 Alabama Railway Association.

(12) The Executive Director of Operation
Lifesaver-Alabama, or his or her designee.

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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That all state agencies are urged to cooperate fully with the commission in accomplishing the objectives of the commission, and that a copy of this resolution be presented to the Governor so that our sincere and continuing interest in this matter is known.
