26	prior to the occurrence of the event, unless such failure of
27	delivery was due to an act or omission of the purchaser.

f. The ticket does not provide the consumer admission to the event for which it was purchased.

- (3) The refund shall include the full price paid by the consumer for the ticket, in addition to all fees charged in connection with that purchase, including, but not limited to, download, delivery, and shipping fees.
- (f) Nothing in this section shall prohibit a ticket issuer or ticket platform from taking reasonable steps to remediate incidents of fraud or from implementing consumer protection policies that exceed the minimum standards set forth in this section.
