8 On page 6, delete lines 22 through 27 in their
9 entirety and insert in lieu thereof the following:

10 "a. For a first offense, the person shall be
11 required to attend defensive driving school.

12 "b. For a second or subsequent offense, the
13 privileges of the Stage II license shall be suspended and the
14 person shall be required to revert to a Stage I learner's
15 permit for a period of six months prior to eligibility to
16 reapply for a Stage II license.

17 "c. The person shall be subject to a fine of not
18 less than one hundred fifty dollars (\$150) and not exceeding
19 three hundred fifty dollars (\$350), plus court costs.

21 On page 7, lines 4 through 8, delete subdivision (2)
22 in its entirety and insert in lieu thereof the following new
23 subdivision (2):

24 "(2) Upon a second or subsequent offense, a parent
25 or legal guardian who knowingly allows his or her child or
26 ward with a Stage I or Stage II license to drive a motor
27 vehicle in violation of the applicable restrictions of the

1 license may be subject to a fine of not less than one hundred
2 fifty dollars (\$150) and not exceeding three hundred fifty
3 dollars (\$350), plus court costs.
