8 On page 8, line 23, after "subsection" delete "(c)"
9 and insert "(d)"

10 On page 14, delete lines 18 through 22 inclusive,
11 and insert in lieu thereof the following:

12 "(3) Of the veteran or serviceman having been a
13 permanent resident of the State of Alabama for at least two
14 years immediately prior to the filing of the application for
15 benefits under this chapter or has filed an Alabama income tax
16 return as a resident individual for the previous ten years. If
17 the veteran or serviceman is deceased, their dependent may
18 still qualify if the veteran or serviceman met this residency
19 requirement at the time of their death. Alabama income tax
20 return information, including but not limited to the type of
21 return filed, necessary to show the residency requirements
22 under this chapter have been met is hereby exempted from the
23 confidentiality provisions of Section 40-2A-10, Code of
24 Alabama 1975, and shall be provided by the Department of
25 Revenue to the Department of Veterans Affairs upon request.
26 Such requests and the significance of the information provided
27 shall be requested by the Department of Veterans Affairs as

1 necessary when other residency information is not available,
2 and the department shall promulgate rules and procedures to
3 effect the provisions of this section."

4 On page 17 line 3, delete "Any amount of tuition"
5 and insert in lieu thereof the following: "Any amount of
6 in-state tuition, books, or fees "

7 On page 18, line 6, delete "\$5,000,000" and insert
8 "\$10,000,000"

9 On page 18, line 13, after "Alabama." insert the
10 following:

11 Such payments or reimbursements shall be made timely
12 at the end of each academic quarter or semester for all
13 tuition reimbursements, and shall be made on the basis of
14 certified invoices submitted by such institution or school to
15 the Alabama Commission on Higher Education, and shall be
16 supported by names of the students receiving such benefits,
17 together with the amounts claimed for each student.
