19	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
20	Section 1. (a) For the purposes of this act,
21	intermittent food service establishment shall mean any entity
22	that has a physical address within Mobile County that does not
23	prepare or serve food in its regular line of business but
24	prepares and serves food on an intermittent basis for a period
25	of time not to exceed three days per week, at a single,
26	specified or designated location in conjunction with a

recurring event such as a local or regional celebration, tradition, custom, or cultural event.

- (b) An intermittent food service establishment shall complete an online application on the Mobile County Public Health website, at no charge, two business days before the event for an exemption of food service at a temporary food event. The operator of the temporary food event shall have knowledge of the proper temperature for food service, have a handwashing facility, and plan for adequate garbage containment.
  - (c) Other than subsection (b), the Mobile County
    Health Department shall not regulate an intermittent food
    service establishment that prepares food in association with a
    regional celebration or tradition when the establishment does
    not prepare, sell, or distribute food on a regular basis or in
    its regular line of business.

Section 2. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
