10 TO BE ENTITLED

13 Relating to Colbert County; to provide further for
14 the expense allowance and compensation of the Colbert County
15 Revenue Commissioner; and to provide that this act is remedial
16 and retroactive to October 1, 1997.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

18 Section 1. The Revenue Commissioner of Colbert
19 County shall be entitled to receive an additional expense
20 allowance in the amount of five thousand dollars (\$5,000) per
21 annum, which shall be in addition to all other expense
22 allowances, compensation, or salary provided by law. The
23 expense allowances shall be payable in equal bimonthly
24 installments from the General Fund of Colbert County.

25 Section 2. Effective beginning with the next term of
26 office, the annual salary of the Revenue Commissioner of
27 Colbert County shall be increased by five thousand dollars

1 (\$5,000) and the expense allowance provided for in Section 1
2 shall be null and void.

3 Section 3. Notwithstanding any other provision of
4 law, in addition to any other compensation provided to the
5 Colbert County Revenue Commissioner, the Colbert County
6 Revenue Commissioner shall continue to receive any
7 cost-of-living or other salary increases granted by the
8 Colbert County Commission to other elected officials in the
9 county.

10 Section 4. The provisions of this law are remedial
11 and curative and shall be retroactive to October 1, 1997. All
12 salary supplements and expense allowances paid from the County
13 Treasury to the person holding the office of Colbert County
14 Revenue Commissioner during the period beginning October 1,
15 1997, and ending on the effective date of this act, in
16 accordance with this act are ratified and confirmed.

17 Section 5. This act shall become effective
18 immediately following its passage and approval by the
19 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
