13 Relating to Pike County; to provide for the
14 assessment of additional court costs in certain civil,
15 criminal, or quasi-criminal proceedings in municipal,
16 district, and circuit courts of Pike County; to provide that
17 the costs, upon collection, shall be distributed to a special
18 fund, designated as the "Jail Fund," in the county treasury to
19 be expended by the county for maintaining, repairing, and
20 operating the county jail or jail complex.

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

22 Section 1. (a) In addition to any court costs now or
23 hereafter authorized to be collected, there shall be assessed
24 an additional court cost of thirty-five dollars (\$35) in all
25 civil cases filed in the district or circuit court of Pike
26 County, excluding cases filed in small claims court.

1 (b) In addition to any court costs now or hereafter
2 authorized to be collected, there shall be assessed an
3 additional court cost of thirty-five dollars (\$35) in all
4 criminal and quasi-criminal cases brought in the municipal,
5 district, or circuit courts of Pike County.

6 Section 2. All costs assessed pursuant to this act
7 shall be collected by the court clerk as other court costs are
8 collected and distributed to the county for deposit in a
9 special fund designated as the Jail Fund. All monies paid into
10 the Jail Fund shall be expended by the county exclusively for
11 the payment of the cost of maintaining, repairs, and operating
12 the county jail or jail complex.

13 Section 3. This act shall become effective on the
14 first day of the third month following its passage and
15 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
