13 Relating to Marshall County; to require that certain  
14 privately-owned wastewater systems in the county be subject to  
15 oversight by the Alabama Public Service Commission.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

17 Section 1. This bill shall apply to any wastewater  
18 system in Marshall County which, as of the effective date of  
19 this act, serves one or more developments, is designed and  
20 permitted for discharge of wastewater directly to surface  
21 waters of the state, is regulated by the Department of  
22 Environmental Management, and serves less than 200 customers.

23 Section 2. The Public Service Commission shall  
24 promulgate and enforce such rules as are necessary to certify  
25 and monitor the economic viability of wastewater management  
26 systems which are described in Section 1. Such regulations  
27 shall include a requirement that rate charges to customers for

1 wastewater system service shall be approved by the Public  
2 Service Commission pursuant to the laws, rules, regulations,  
3 and procedures pertaining to utilities.

4 Section 3. This act shall become effective  
5 immediately following its passage and approval by the  
6 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
