11 WHEREAS, it is with profound sorrow that we note the
12 death on February 11, 1017, of Mrs. Cora Ida "Gray" Amesbury
13 Donaldson of Troy, Alabama, at the age of 95 years; and

14 WHEREAS, her passing leaves a void in the lives of
15 her loving family, many friends, and the entire community,
16 where she was highly regarded; and

17 WHEREAS, Mrs. Donaldson was born in Beatrice,
18 Alabama, on April 16, 1921, to William Henry Gray and Lucy
19 Cora Daugette; and

20 WHEREAS, growing up in Rosinton, Alabama, she
21 attended the Rosinton Methodist Church, where Reverend Sid
22 Mathison was a significant spiritual influence in her life;
23 later she enjoyed hearing his son, Dr. John Ed Mathison,
24 preach at The Church in the Pines on Lake Martin; and

25 WHEREAS, a 1939 graduate of Robertsdale High School,
26 Mrs. Donaldson was the first in her family to receive a high
27 school diploma; and

1 WHEREAS, after graduation, she moved to Mobile to
2 begin her career at Gayfers Department Store, where she gained
3 a loyal clientele and received numerous awards for her top
4 sales and teamwork; and

5 WHEREAS, in July 1949, she married Thomas Richard
6 Amesbury, a union which produced two daughters, Patsy and
7 Kathy; and

8 WHEREAS, in April 1978, she married Gene Donaldson
9 and together they enjoyed traveling, gardening, and spending
10 time with grandchildren; and

11 WHEREAS, Mrs. Donaldson was preceded in death by her
12 parents, eight siblings, husband, and son-in-law, Kenneth H.
13 Weed, Sr.; and

14 WHEREAS, survivors include daughters, Patricia
15 Amesbury Weed-Hollis (Jerry) and Kathryn Gray Amesbury
16 Campbell (Kenny); grandchildren, Scarlet Weed Stokes (Brent),
17 Kenneth Harper Weed, Jr., (Kim), Stephanie Gray Campbell Baker
18 (Matt), Ellen Weed Estes (Ricky), Troy Thomas Weed (Ashley),
