- "(3) He or she, being 16 years or older, engages in sexual intercourse with a member of the opposite sex who is less than 12 years old.
 - "(b) Rape in the first degree is a Class A felony.
- "(c) If a person is convicted of rape in the first degree pursuant to this section and a child is born as a result of the rape, the defendant shall have his or her parental rights to the child terminated pursuant to Article 3 of Chapter 15 of Title 12."

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
