8 SYNOPSIS: This bill would propose an amendment to the  
9 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, to require that  
10 the members of the Shelby County Board of Education  
11 and the Shelby County Superintendent of Education  
12 be elected by the qualified electors of the county  
13 who reside outside of the corporate limits of any  
14 city located within the county that has a separate  
15 city board of education.

21 To propose an amendment to the Constitution of  
22 Alabama of 1901, pertaining only to Shelby County; to require  
23 that the members of the county board of education and the  
24 county superintendent of education be elected by the qualified  
25 electors of the county residing outside of the corporate  
26 limits of any city with a separate board of education.
