11 Relating to students; to allow students in public  
12 and nonpublic schools the option to possess and use federal  
13 Food and Drug Administration regulated over-the-counter  
14 sunscreen at school and at school-based events.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

16 Section 1. (a) Any student in a public school under  
17 the jurisdiction of a local board of education or in a  
18 nonpublic school may possess and apply federal Food and Drug  
19 Administration regulated over-the-counter sunscreen at school  
20 and at school-based events notwithstanding any other provision  
21 of law, including any rule of the State Board of Education or  
22 the State Board of Nursing.

23 (b) No rule of the State Board of Education or the  
24 State Board of Nursing shall apply to the possession or use of  
25 federal Food and Drug Administration regulated  
26 over-the-counter sunscreen by students at a public or  
27 nonpublic school.

1                   (c) Any student, parent, or guardian requesting a  
2 school board employee to apply sunscreen to a student shall  
3 present to the nurse a Parent Prescriber Authorization Form  
4 (PPA) containing a parent or guardian signature. A physician  
5 signature or physician order shall not be required.

6                   Section 2. This act shall become effective  
7 immediately following its passage and approval by the  
8 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
