5 COMMENDING ALTON R. BARNES, SR., FOR OUTSTANDING
6 SERVICE TO THE STATE OF ALABAMA.

8 WHEREAS, highest commendations are herein proudly
9 presented to Alton R. Barnes, Sr., for outstanding service to
10 the State of Alabama; and

11 WHEREAS, Alton R. Barnes, Sr., learned the
12 importance of hard work while growing up on a dairy farm near
13 the cotton mill town of Sycamore, Alabama; he served with much
14 honor as a member of the 158th Regiment Combat Team in the
15 Pacific Theater during World War II; upon returning home, he
16 obtained many life milestones including marrying his wife,
17 joining the Alabama National Guard as a second lieutenant,
18 finishing high school, and entering Jacksonville State
19 University, where he earned a Bachelor of Science Degree in
20 Education; and

21 WHEREAS, Alton R. Barnes, Sr., taught for one year
22 at the high school level; he was called into active duty a
23 second time and served in Japan during the Korean War; after
24 his service, he returned to the Alabama Army National Guard
25 and later went to work with the Guard full time in Talladega,

1 Alabama, as a command administrative assistant; in 1956, he
2 was selected by the Guard's Adjutant General to organize the
3 Alabama Guard's first officer candidate school, the Alabama
4 Military Academy; he commanded the program for more than 20
5 years; his leadership and dedication to the program of
6 training future officers known as AMA (Alabama Military
7 Academy) impacted the quality of the leadership in the Alabama
8 National Guard; this quality of leadership allowed Alabama to
9 be recognized as the best State National Guard organization in
10 America during those years; the direct influence provided by
11 Colonel Barnes to hundreds of individuals has allowed them to
12 be successful not only as military leaders but leaders in
13 their communities, counties, and our state; these individuals
14 saw their lives drastically improved by Colonel Barnes
15 leadership; he retired with the rank of Colonel while serving
16 as Assistant Adjutant General of Alabama; and

17 WHEREAS, four years later, Alton R. Barnes, Sr.,
18 entered his appointment as Assistant Administrator of the ABC
19 Board, and retired after three years of service; during
20 retirement, he has been active volunteering and benefitting
21 seniors through his magnanimous actions; he was inducted into
22 the Senior Citizens Hall of Fame in 1996 and received a Senior
23 Achievement Award in 1998; for 20 years, he volunteered with
24 Baptist Hospital's Senior Advantage Program; notably, he
25 organized and oversaw the hospital's first fun time band and

1 visited nursing homes and rest facilities for 16 years; a
2 faithful and devoted Christian, he continues to sing with
3 Frazer Memorial's Older Adult Choir and substitutes teaching
4 Sunday School at 93 years of age; and

5 WHEREAS, through the years, Alton R. Barnes, Sr.,
6 has earned widespread admiration and respect for his tireless
7 dedication and exceptional abilities, and he is truly
8 deserving of special commendation and praise; now therefore,

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
10 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That Alton R. Barnes, Sr., is
11 highly honored and commended, and this resolution is offered
12 to him in deepest admiration and appreciation for his
13 invaluable service to the State of Alabama, as well as in
14 sincere best wishes for the future.
