5 past president of School Superintendents of Alabama and a
6 member of the Huntsville Botanical Board, Boy Scouts of
7 America Board, United Way of Madison County Board, University
8 of Alabama Capstone Education Society Board of Advisors and
9 Council for Leaders in Alabama Schools Board of Directors; and

10 WHEREAS, in 2008, Dr. Fowler was selected as a
11 finalist for State Superintendent of the Year by the School
12 Superintendents of Alabama Association

13 WHEREAS, Dr. Fowler was named Superintendent of the
14 Year by the Alabama Parent Teacher Association; and

15 WHEREAS, Dr. Fowler and his wife, Marcia, have one
16 son, James, who is married to the former Margaret McCrummen of
17 Mobile, Alabama; now therefore,
