6 W. VAUGHN HIGHWAY.

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8 WHEREAS, Donald W. Vaughn, P.E., retired from the
9 Alabama Department of Transportation in June 2012 after a
10 career of distinguished service to the State of Alabama over
11 the span of 46 years; and

12 WHEREAS, he retired as Chief Engineer/Deputy
13 Director of the Department, having begun work with the Alabama
14 Highway Department in 1966 and continuing to work during the
15 summer months and between quarters while attending Auburn
16 University; and

17 WHEREAS, upon graduation in 1972, he began full-time
18 work in the Engineering Education Training Program as a
19 Graduate Civil Engineer and was promoted steadily to positions
20 of increasing responsibility in the Interstate Bureau, Design
21 Bureau, and as Office Engineer Bureau Chief; and

22 WHEREAS, he was part of every major road and bridge
23 construction project in Alabama during parts of six decades,
24 including being on the team that produced the first cost
25 estimate and alignment for Interstate 22; and

1 WHEREAS, he developed and trained countless
2 employees for positions of significant responsibility
3 including dozens who have become Bureau Chiefs, Region
4 Engineers, Deputy Directors, and Chief Engineers, providing
5 tremendous vision and direction for the department during his
6 career and for decades to come; now therefore,

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
8 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That U. S. Highway 231 from its
9 intersection with Todd Road in Montgomery, at mile marker
10 112.207, to its intersection with Huntress Street in Wetumpka,
11 at mile marker 119.327, be designated the Donald W. Vaughn
12 Highway.

13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Department of
14 Transportation is requested to determine the cost of
15 fabricating and erecting the appropriate signs or markers,
16 consistent with applicable requirements and laws, and upon
17 receiving funds from non-state sources covering that cost, to
18 erect those signs or markers as provided in this resolution in
19 recognition of this meritorious designation.
