11 death on February 17, 2017, of Horace Sellers Merrill of
12 Heflin, Alabama, at the age of 80 years; and

26 Baptist Church for more than 50 years, served as a Deacon,

1 Training Director, and Sanctuary Choir member and was pastor
2 of several area churches; and

3 WHEREAS, survivors include his loving wife of 53
4 years, Mary Thompson Merrill; son, Alabama Secretary of State
5 John Harold Merrill (Cindy); daughter, Audrey Merrill Gillis
6 (Stephen); grandchildren, Pelham Brooks Merrill, Alexandra
7 Grace Merrill, Mary Kathryn Gillis, and Sarah Sellers Gillis;
8 sister, Doris Sue Belcher; and brother, Stanley Merrill (Sue);
9 he was preceded in death by his parents; and

10 WHEREAS, Mr. Merrill was a valued member of the
11 community; although his presence will be missed, his memory is
12 cherished in the hearts of all those who knew and loved him;
