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3 HOUSE HEALTH COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR SB39
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8 SYNOPSIS: This bill would add certain named chemical
9 compounds of Fentanyl and synthetic controlled
10 substance Fentanyl analogues to Schedule I of the
11 controlled substances list. Possession,
12 distribution, and trafficking of these compounds
13 would be deemed unlawful, and violations would be
14 subject to the existing criminal penalties, as well
15 as enhanced penalties, for distribution.

16 This bill would provide criminal penalties
17 for trafficking of Fentanyl or any synthetic
18 controlled substance Fentanyl analogue added to
19 Schedule I.

20 This bill would also provide for the
21 charging of a defendant for trafficking of certain
22 controlled substances, including Fentanyl and
23 synthetic controlled substance Fentanyl analogues,
24 if the person possesses 50 or more individual
25 packages of the substance, notwithstanding the
26 required weight ranges for trafficking.

1 Amendment 621 of the Constitution of Alabama
2 of 1901, now appearing as Section 111.05 of the
3 Official Recompilation of the Constitution of
4 Alabama of 1901, as amended, prohibits a general
5 law whose purpose or effect would be to require a
6 new or increased expenditure of local funds from
7 becoming effective with regard to a local
8 governmental entity without enactment by a 2/3 vote
9 unless: it comes within one of a number of
10 specified exceptions; it is approved by the
11 affected entity; or the Legislature appropriates
12 funds, or provides a local source of revenue, to
13 the entity for the purpose.

14 The purpose or effect of this bill would be
15 to require a new or increased expenditure of local
16 funds within the meaning of the amendment. However,
17 the bill does not require approval of a local
18 governmental entity or enactment by a 2/3 vote to
19 become effective because it comes within one of the
20 specified exceptions contained in the amendment.

18 Section 1. Sections 13A-12-211, 13A-12-231, and
19 Section 20-2-23, Code of Alabama 1975, are amended to read as

23 distribution of controlled substances if, except as otherwise
24 authorized, he or she sells, furnishes, gives away, delivers,
25 or distributes a controlled substance enumerated in Schedules

2 is a Class B felony.

3 "(c) A person commits the crime of unlawful
4 possession with intent to distribute a controlled substance
5 if, except as otherwise authorized by law, he or she knowingly
6 possesses any of the following quantities of a controlled
7 substance:

8 "(1) More than eight grams, but less than 28 grams,
9 of cocaine or of any mixture containing cocaine.

10 "(2) More than two grams, but less than four grams,
11 of any morphine, opium, or any salt, isomer, or salt of an
12 isomer thereof, including heroin.

13 "(3) More than eight grams, but less than 28 grams,
14 of 3,4-methylenedioxy amphetamine, or of any mixture
15 containing 3,4-methylenedioxy amphetamine.

16 "(4) More than eight grams, but less than 28 grams,
17 of 5-methoxy-3, 4-methylenedioxy amphetamine, or of any
18 mixture containing 5-methoxy-3, 4-methylenedioxy amphetamine.

19 "(5) More than eight grams, but less than 28 grams,
20 of amphetamine or any mixture containing amphetamine, its
21 salt, optical isomer, or salt of its optical isomer thereof.

22 "(6) More than eight grams, but less than 28 grams,
23 of methamphetamine or any mixture containing methamphetamine,
24 its salts, optical isomers, or salt of its optical isomers
25 thereof.

1 "(7) More than one-half gram, but less than one
2 gram, of Fentanyl or any synthetic controlled substance
3 Fentanyl analogue, as a single component.

4 "(8) More than two grams, but less than four grams,
5 of any mixture containing Fentanyl or any synthetic controlled
6 substance Fentanyl analogue or any other controlled substance.

7 "(d) Unlawful possession with intent to distribute a
8 controlled substance is a Class B felony.

9 "§13A-12-231.

10 "Except as authorized in Chapter 2, Title 20:

11 "(1) Any person who knowingly sells, manufactures,
12 delivers, or brings into this state, or who is knowingly in
13 actual or constructive possession of, in excess of one kilo or
14 2.2 pounds of any part of the plant of the genus Cannabis,
15 whether growing or not, the seeds thereof, the resin extracted
16 from any part of the plant, and every compound, manufacture,
17 salt, derivative, mixture, or preparation of the plant, its
18 seeds, or resin including the completely defoliated mature
19 stalks of the plant, fiber produced from the stalks, oil, or
20 cake, or the completely sterilized samples of seeds of the
21 plant which are incapable of germination is guilty of a
22 felony, which felony shall be known as "trafficking in
23 cannabis." Nothing in this subdivision shall apply to samples
24 of tetrahydrocannabinols including, but not limited to, all
25 synthetic or naturally produced samples of
26 tetrahydrocannabinols which contain more than 15 percent by
27 weight of tetrahydrocannabinols and which do not contain plant

1 material exhibiting the external morphological features of the
2 plant cannabis. If the quantity of cannabis involved:

3 "a. Is in excess of one kilo or 2.2 pounds, but less
4 than 100 pounds, the person shall be sentenced to a mandatory

20 of any mixture containing any such substance, is guilty of a
21 felony, which felony shall be known as "trafficking in illegal
22 drugs." If the quantity involved:

23 "a. Is four grams or more, but less than 14 grams,
24 the person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of
25 imprisonment of three calendar years and to pay a fine of
26 fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000).

1 "b. Is 14 grams or more, but less than 28 grams, the
2 person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of
3 imprisonment of 10 calendar years and to pay a fine of one

10 et seq., is guilty of a felony which shall be known as
11 "trafficking in illegal drugs." If the quantity involved:

12 "a. Is 500 pills or capsules or more but less than
13 1,000 pills or capsules, the person shall be sentenced to a
14 mandatory term of imprisonment of three calendar years and to
15 pay a fine of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000).

16 "b. Is 1,000 pills or capsules or more, but less
17 than 4,000 pills or capsules, the person shall be sentenced to
18 a mandatory term of imprisonment of 10 calendar years and to
19 pay a fine of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000).

20 "c. Is 4,000 pills or capsules or more but less than
21 10,000 pills or capsules, the person shall be sentenced to a
22 mandatory term of imprisonment of 25 calendar years and to pay

4 3,4-methylenedioxy amphetamine, or of any mixture containing
5 3,4-methylenedioxy amphetamine, is guilty of a felony, which
6 felony shall be known as "trafficking in illegal drugs." If
7 the quantity involved:

8 "a. Is 28 grams or more, but less than 500 grams,
9 the person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of

21 imprisonment of five calendar years and to pay a fine of one

24 person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of
25 imprisonment of 15 calendar years and to pay a fine of two

7 methamphetamine or any mixture containing methamphetamine, its
8 salts, optical isomers, or salt of its optical isomers
9 thereof, is guilty of a felony, which felony shall be known as
10 "trafficking in methamphetamine." If the quantity involved:

11 "a. Is 28 grams or more but less than 500 grams, the
12 person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of
13 imprisonment of three calendar years and to pay a fine of
14 fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000).

15 "b. Is 500 grams or more, but less than one kilo,
16 the person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of
17 imprisonment of five calendar years and to pay a fine of one
18 hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000).

19 "c. Is one kilo but less than 10 kilos, then the
20 person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of
21 imprisonment of 15 calendar years and to pay a fine of two
22 hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000).

23 "d. Is 10 kilos or more, the person shall be
24 sentenced to a mandatory term of imprisonment of life ~~without~~
25 ~~parole~~.

26 "(12) Any person who knowingly sells, manufactures,

2 synthetic controlled substance or a synthetic controlled
3 substance analogue, as described in subdivision (4) or (5) of
4 subsection (a) of Section 20-2-23, except for any synthetic
5 controlled substance Fentanyl analogue referenced in
6 subdivisions (13) and (14), is guilty of a felony, which
7 felony shall be known as "trafficking in synthetic controlled
8 substances." If the quantity involved:

9 "a. Is 56 grams or more, but less than 500 grams,
10 the person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of
11 imprisonment of three calendar years and to pay a fine of
12 fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000).

13 "b. Is 500 grams or more, but less than 1 kilo, the
14 person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of
15 imprisonment of 10 calendar years and to pay a fine of one
16 hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000).

18 person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of

27 possession of, one gram or more of Fentanyl or any synthetic

1 controlled substance Fentanyl analogue, as a single component
2 as described in Sections 20-2-23 and 20-2-25, is guilty of a
3 felony, which felony shall be known as "trafficking in illegal
4 drugs." If the quantity involved:

5 "a. Is one gram or more, but less than two grams,
6 the person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of
7 imprisonment of three calendar years and to pay a fine of
8 fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000).

9 "b. Is two grams or more, but less than four grams,
10 the person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of
11 imprisonment of 10 calendar years and to pay a fine of one
12 hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000).

13 "c. Is four grams or more, but less than eight
14 grams, the person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum
15 term of imprisonment of 25 calendar years and to pay a fine of
16 five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000).

17 "d. Is eight grams or more, the person shall be
18 sentenced to a mandatory term of imprisonment of life.

19 "(14) Any person, unless otherwise authorized, who
20 knowingly sells, manufactures, delivers, or brings into this
21 state, or who is knowingly in actual or constructive
22 possession of, four grams or more of any mixture containing
23 Fentanyl or any synthetic controlled substance Fentanyl
24 analogue, as described in Sections 20-2-23 and 20-2-25 or any
25 other controlled substance component, is guilty of a felony,
26 which felony shall be known as "trafficking in illegal drugs."
27 If the quantity involved:

1 "a. Is four grams or more, but less than 14 grams,
2 the person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of
3 imprisonment of three calendar years and to pay a fine of
4 fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000).

5 "b. Is 14 grams or more, but less than 28 grams, the
6 person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of
7 imprisonment of 10 calendar years and to pay a fine of one

3 state law but which have a potential for abuse similar to or
4 greater than that for substances controlled under existing
5 state law. These new synthetic substances are called
6 "synthetic controlled substances or synthetic controlled
7 substance analogues" and can be designed to produce a desired
8 pharmacological effect and to evade the controlling statutory
9 provisions. Synthetic controlled substances or synthetic
10 controlled substance analogues are being manufactured,
11 distributed, possessed, and used as substitutes for controlled
12 substances.

13 "(2) The hazards attributable to the traffic in and
14 use of a synthetic controlled substance or synthetic
15 controlled substance analogues are increased because their
16 unregulated manufacture produces variations in purity and
17 concentration.

18 "(3) Many new synthetic substances are untested, and
19 it cannot be immediately determined whether they have useful
20 medical or chemical purposes.

21 "(4) The uncontrolled importation, manufacture,
22 distribution, possession, or use of controlled substance
23 analogues has a substantial and detrimental impact on the
24 health and safety of the people of this state.

25 "(5) Synthetic controlled substances or synthetic
26 controlled substance analogues can be created more rapidly
27 than they can be identified and controlled by action of the

1 Legislature. There is a need for a speedy determination of
2 their proper classification under existing law. It is
3 therefore necessary to identify and classify new substances
4 that have a potential for abuse, so that they can be
5 controlled in the same manner as other substances controlled
6 under existing state law.

14 person is registered as a controlled substance researcher as
15 required under section 152.12, subdivision 3, to the extent
16 conduct with respect to the substance is pursuant to the
17 exemption and registration.

18 "c. A controlled substance analogue is treated as a
19 controlled substance in Schedule I.

20 "d. After the Alabama Department of Forensic
21 Sciences has determined a substance to be a synthetic
22 controlled substance analogue under this section, the
23 department shall notify the Alabama Department of Public
24 Health with information relevant to scheduling as provided by
25 Section 20-2-20."

1 Section 2. The amendatory language in this act shall
2 only apply to offenses occurring on or after the effective
3 date of this act and shall not apply retroactively.

4 Section 3. Although this bill would have as its
5 purpose or effect the requirement of a new or increased
6 expenditure of local funds, the bill is excluded from further
7 requirements and application under Amendment 621, now
8 appearing as Section 111.05 of the Official Recompilation of
9 the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, because the
10 bill defines a new crime or amends the definition of an
11 existing crime.

12 Section 4. This act shall become effective
13 immediately following its passage and approval by the
14 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
