9 SYNOPSIS: Under existing law, the State Pilotage
10 Commission has three members appointed by the
11 Governor.

12 This bill would increase the membership of
13 the commission from three to four members, would
14 provide for the appointment of the additional
15 advisory member by the Chair of the Alabama State
16 Port Authority; and would provide that the
17 additional advisory member serve without expense
18 reimbursement.

20 A BILL
21 TO BE ENTITLED
22 AN ACT

24 To amend Sections 33-4-1 and 33-4-3, Code of Alabama
25 1975, relating to the State Pilotage Commission, to increase
26 the membership of the commission from three to four members;
27 to provide for the appointment of the additional advisory

1 member by the Chair of the Alabama State Port Authority; and
2 to provide that the additional advisory member serve without
3 expense reimbursement.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

5 Section 1. Sections 33-4-1 and 33-4-3 of the Code of
6 Alabama 1975, are amended to read as follows:

7 "§33-4-1.

8 "There shall be a board of pilotage commissioners,
9 to be known as the State Pilotage Commission, which shall
10 consist of ~~three~~ four members, one to be an official of a
11 steamship company which maintains an office in Mobile, one to
12 be an active bar pilot, licensed and branched by ~~such~~ the
13 State Pilotage Commission, ~~and~~ one to be a business ~~man~~ person
14 or in a professional occupation licensed by the State of
15 Alabama, and one, appointed by the Chair of the Alabama State
16 Port Authority, to serve in a nonvoting, advisory capacity.

17 The membership of the commission shall be inclusive and
18 reflect the racial, gender, geographic, urban/rural, and
19 economic diversity of the state. Such State Pilotage
20 Commission shall have such powers and duties as are prescribed
21 in this chapter and as may hereafter be prescribed by law. A
22 quorum for the transaction of the business of the commission
23 shall be two commissioners.

24 "§33-4-3.

25 "The Governor shall appoint ~~said~~ the three
26 commissioners who are not appointed by the Chair of the
27 Alabama State Port Authority pursuant to Section 33-4-1. All

1 commissioners shall be appointed to hold office for six years
2 from the dates of appointment through the expiration of their
3 respective commissions and until their successors are
4 qualified. The commissioners shall serve without compensation,
5 ~~but all.~~ The traveling expenses incurred by the three
6 commissioners appointed by the Governor, in the performance of
7 their duties, shall be paid out of funds in the treasury of
8 the commission. The commissioner appointed by the Chair of the
9 Alabama State Port Authority shall serve without reimbursement
10 of his or her expenses incurred on behalf of the commission."

11 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
12 first day of the third month following its passage and
13 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
