24	To amend Sections 33-4-1 and 33-4-3, Code of Alabama
25	1975, relating to the State Pilotage Commission, to increase
26	the membership of the commission from three to four members;
27	to provide for the appointment of the additional advisory

member by the Chair of the Alabama State Port Authority; and to provide that the additional advisory member serve without expense reimbursement.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Sections 33-4-1 and 33-4-3 of the Code of Alabama 1975, are amended to read as follows:

"§33-4-1.

"There shall be a board of pilotage commissioners, to be known as the State Pilotage Commission, which shall consist of three four members, one to be an official of a steamship company which maintains an office in Mobile, one to be an active bar pilot, licensed and branched by such the State Pilotage Commission, and one to be a business man person or in a professional occupation licensed by the State of Alabama, and one, appointed by the Chair of the Alabama State Port Authority, to serve in a nonvoting, advisory capacity. The membership of the commission shall be inclusive and reflect the racial, gender, geographic, urban/rural, and economic diversity of the state. Such State Pilotage Commission shall have such powers and duties as are prescribed in this chapter and as may hereafter be prescribed by law. A quorum for the transaction of the business of the commission shall be two commissioners.

"§33-4-3.

"The Governor shall appoint said the three commissioners who are not appointed by the Chair of the Alabama State Port Authority pursuant to Section 33-4-1. All

commissioners shall be appointed to hold office for six years from the dates of appointment through the expiration of their respective commissions and until their successors are qualified. The commissioners shall serve without compensation, but all. The traveling expenses incurred by the three commissioners appointed by the Governor, in the performance of their duties, shall be paid out of funds in the treasury of the commission. The commissioner appointed by the Chair of the Alabama State Port Authority shall serve without reimbursement of his or her expenses incurred on behalf of the commission."

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
