8 Beginning on page 73, line 26 and continuing through
9 page 74, line 3, delete subsection (e) and insert in lieu
10 thereof the following:

11 (e) The Administrative Office of Courts shall
12 partner with the Sentencing Commission, the Department of
13 Youth Services, and any other agency necessary, to collect,
14 analyze, and report on juvenile data to assist the oversight
15 committee. Such information shall include, but not be limited
16 to, tracking a juvenile's trajectory through the juvenile or
17 adult justice system, case history across counties, recidivism
18 rates, efficacy of specific county programs, outcomes after a
19 child leaves the juvenile justice system, and any disparate
20 impact of Alabama's juvenile justice system related to gender,
21 race, and ethnicity. Data collected under this subsection
22 shall be included in the annual report mandated in subdivision
23 (d)(4). Provided, however, that identifying personal
24 information may be redacted from the report.
