8 On page 40, line 13, after "court." insert the
9 following:

10 Notwithstanding the foregoing, for juveniles
11 committed to the custody of the Department of Youth Services,
12 the juvenile probation officer shall electronically transfer
13 the valid court order and the risk assessment and social
14 evaluation previously submitted to the court to the department
15 and the regional detention facility where the juvenile is
16 detained within two business days of the commitment. The
17 department shall be responsible for the cost of housing,
18 medical care, and other expenses for the juvenile following
19 the eighth business day after such receipt. The eight-day
20 limit may be extended, with the consent of the county
21 commission and sheriff, to allow the consolidation of
22 transportation for two or more children being transferred to
23 the custody of the Department of Youth Services.
