5	"(a) There shall be a board of pilotage
6	commissioners, to be known as the State Pilotage Commission,
7	which shall consist of three voting members, one to . One
8	member shall be an official of a steamship company which
9	maintains an office in Mobile, one to member shall be an
10	active bar pilot, licensed and branched by such the State
11	Pilotage Commission, and one to member shall be a business mar
12	businessperson or engaged in a professional occupation
13	licensed by the State of Alabama.
