8 SYNOPSIS: Under existing law, termination dates are  
9 established for enumerated state agencies. The  
10 agencies are periodically reviewed by the Alabama  
11 Sunset Committee. After the review process is  
12 completed, the committee prepares its  
13 recommendations for the agencies to the Legislature  
14 in the form of sunset bills which either continue,  
15 terminate, or continue with modification each  
16 agency reviewed.

17 This bill would provide for the continuance  
18 of the State Pilotage Commission until October 1,  
19 2020, with the following change: To authorize the  
20 Governor to appoint an advisory member to the  
21 commission.

24 TO BE ENTITLED  
25 AN ACT

1           Relating to the Alabama Sunset Law; to continue the  
2 existence and functioning of the State Pilotage Commission  
3 until October 1, 2020, with certain modifications; to amend  
4 Section 33-4-1, Code of Alabama 1975, to authorize the  
5 Governor to appoint an advisory member to the commission.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

7           Section 1. Pursuant to the Alabama Sunset Law, the  
8 Sunset Committee recommends the continuance of the State  
9 Pilotage Commission until October 1, 2020, with the additional  
10 recommendation for statutory change as set out in Section 3.

11           Section 2. The existence and functioning of the  
12 State Pilotage Commission, created and functioning pursuant to  
13 Sections 33-4-1 to 33-4-57, inclusive, Code of Alabama 1975,  
14 is continued until October 1, 2020, and those code sections  
15 are expressly preserved.

16           Section 3. Section 33-4-1 of the Code of Alabama  
17 1975, is amended to read as follows:

18           "§33-4-1.

19           "(a) There shall be a board of pilotage  
20 commissioners, to be known as the State Pilotage Commission,  
21 which shall consist of three voting members, ~~one to~~. One  
22 voting member shall be an official of a steamship company  
23 which maintains an office in Mobile, ~~one to~~ voting member  
24 shall be an active bar pilot, licensed and branched by ~~such~~  
25 the State Pilotage Commission, and ~~one to~~ voting member shall  
26 be a business ~~man~~ person or a person engaged in a professional  
27 occupation licensed by the State of Alabama.

1           "(b) An additional member, who shall serve in a  
2 nonvoting advisory capacity, may be appointed to the  
3 commission by the Governor from a list of nominations by the  
4 Chair of the Alabama State Port Authority. Any provision of  
5 Section 33-4-3 to the contrary notwithstanding, the advisory  
6 commissioner shall serve without reimbursement for expenses  
7 incurred on behalf of the commission and shall submit no  
8 commissioner's fees.

9           "(c) The membership of the commission shall be  
10 inclusive and reflect the racial, gender, geographic,  
11 urban/rural, and economic diversity of the state.

12           "(d) The ~~Such~~ State Pilotage Commission shall have  
13 ~~such~~ the powers and duties as are prescribed in this chapter  
14 and as may hereafter be prescribed by law.

15           "(e) A quorum for the transaction of commission  
16 business shall be two voting members of the commission."

17           Section 4. The Legislature concurs in the  
18 recommendations of the Sunset Committee as provided in  
19 Sections 1, 2, and 3.

20           Section 5. This act shall become effective  
21 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or  
22 its otherwise becoming law.
