- 4 Section 1. Section 32-5A-80, Code of Alabama 1975,
- is amended to read as follows:
- 6 "\$32-5A-80.
- "(a) Upon all roadways of sufficient width a vehicle

 shall be driven upon the right half of the roadway, except as

 follows:
 - "(1) When overtaking and passing another vehicle proceeding in the same direction under the rules governing such movement;
 - "(2) When an obstruction exists making it necessary to drive to the left of the center of the highway; provided, any person doing so shall yield the right-of-way to all vehicles traveling in the proper direction upon the unobstructed portion of the highway within such distance as to constitute an immediate hazard:
 - "(3) Upon a roadway divided into three marked lanes for traffic under the rules applicable thereon; or
 - "(4) Upon a roadway restricted to one-way traffic.
 - "(b) Upon all roadways any vehicle proceeding at less than the normal speed of traffic at the time and place and under the conditions then existing shall be driven in the right-hand lane then available for traffic, or as close as practicable to the right-hand curb or edge of the roadway, except when overtaking and passing another vehicle proceeding

in the same direction or when preparing for a left turn at an intersection or into a private road or driveway.

"(c) Upon any roadway having four or more lanes for moving traffic and providing for two-way movement of traffic, no vehicle shall be driven to the left of the center line of the roadway, except when authorized by official traffic-control devices designating certain lanes to the left side of the center of the roadway for use by traffic not otherwise permitted to use such lanes, or except as permitted under subsection (a)(2). However, this subsection shall not be construed as prohibiting the crossing of the center line in making a left turn into or from an alley, private road, or driveway.

"(d) (1) On an interstate or U.S. highway having four lanes of traffic with two lanes moving in each direction, a commercial motor vehicle having three or more axles shall travel in the right lane unless passing a vehicle or vehicles. The commercial vehicle may not travel in the left-most lane in order to pass another vehicle or vehicles for more than two miles without completely passing the other vehicle or vehicles unless traffic does not allow the commercial vehicle to pass and return to the right lane.

"(2) On an interstate or U.S. highway having three or more lanes in each direction, a commercial motor vehicle having three or more axles may not travel in the far left lane.

Τ	"(e) Subsection (d) does not apply to a commercial
2	vehicle under any of the following conditions:
3	"(1) When traffic conditions or congestion make it
4	necessary to operate a commercial vehicle other than as
5	required in subsection (d).
6	"(2) When inclement weather, obstructions, or
7	hazards make it necessary to operate a commercial vehicle
8	other than as required in subsection (d).
9	"(3) When compliance with a law, a rule, an
10	ordinance, or a traffic control device makes it necessary to

Section 3. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
