4	Effective January 1, 2019, the Montgomery Municipal
5	Court in Montgomery County is abolished and all pending cases

8	Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment
9	shall be held in accordance with Sections 284 and 284.01 of
10	the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Sections
11	284 and 284.01 of the Official Recompilation of the
12	Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election
13	laws of this state.
14	Section 3. The appropriate election official shall
15	assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional
16	amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the
17	following description of the substance or subject matter of
18	the proposed constitutional amendment:
19	"Relating to Montgomery County, proposing an
20	amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, to abolish
