10	military personnel have free admission to all

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the Park for Patriots Act of 2018.

Section 2. Section 9-14-8, Code of Alabama 1975, is amended to read as follows:

"\$9-14-8.

"(a) Any active or retired member of the United
States Armed Forces, including any reserve component thereof,
or the National Guard, upon presentation of an appropriate
active or retired military identification card, shall be
granted free admission to any state park operated by the
Department of Conservation and Natural Resources on any state
or federal holiday.

"(b) Any Alabama resident, who is an active member or retired member in good standing of the United States Armed

Forces or National Guard, including any reserve component

thereof, upon presentation of an appropriate active or retired

military identification card, shall be granted free admission

to any state park operated by the Department of Conservation

3	Section 3. All laws or parts of laws which conflict
