13 Relating to Coosa County; to provide an additional
14 fee for the service of failure to appear warrants by the
15 Sheriff of Coosa County.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

17 Section 1. (a) In Coosa County, in addition to any
18 and all court costs, fees, and charges now or hereafter
19 authorized, there shall be assessed by the circuit court clerk
20 a one hundred dollar (\$100) charge on the service of all
21 failure to appear warrants executed by the deputies or Sheriff
22 of Coosa County.

23 (b) The service fee imposed in this section shall be
24 assessed against a defendant upon conviction. The clerk of the
25 court shall enter the amount of the fee provided in this
26 section on the docket sheet and shall collect the fee in the

1 same manner and same time as other court costs. The service
2 fee may be waived by the court for good cause shown.

3 (c) The revenues derived from this fee shall be
4 distributed as follows:

5 (1) Twenty-five dollars (\$25) of the fee shall be
6 distributed to the Sheriff's Office Law Enforcement Fund to be
7 used for law enforcement purposes.

8 (2) Twenty-five dollars (\$25) of the fee shall be
9 distributed to the circuit court clerk.

10 (3) Fifty dollars (\$50) of the fee shall be
11 distributed to the General Fund of Coosa County to be used to
12 provide funding for the operation of the office of the Coosa
13 County Sheriff, including providing hazardous duty pay for
14 deputies.

15 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
16 first day of the third month following its passage and
17 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
