15 its roots to 1914 when "Mr. Jack" Rudder and Colonel Ben Ellis
16 started a venture that provided caskets and a horse-drawn

19 Rudder Funeral Home upon the death of Colonel Ben Ellis and
20 expanded and modernized the business in 1927 with the purchase
21 of a motorized hearse; and

23 "Dinky" Rudder began working at Rudder Funeral Home and
24 completed mortuary school at Gupton-Jones in Nashville,
25 Tennessee, in 1932; and

26 WHEREAS, in the early 1950s, third generation John
27 E. Rudder, began working at Rudder Funeral Home and completed

1 his education at Gupton-Jones in Nashville in 1957; he worked
2 alongside his father, A.G. "Dinky" Rudder, until the passing
3 of A.G. "Dinky" Rudder in August 1967; and

4 WHEREAS, the fourth generation began to work in the
5 family business in 1977, and John Cook Rudder graduated
6 Mortuary School in Birmingham at Jefferson State Community
7 College in 1982; and

8 WHEREAS, the Rudders purchased and began renovating
9 the old Word Funeral Home in Scottsboro, Alabama, in April
10 1983; Rudder Funeral Home hosted open house on Sunday, June 1,
11 1984; and

12 WHEREAS, in 2002, fifth generation Lucas Rudder
13 began working at the funeral home, and he graduated from
14 Jefferson State Community College in 2008; and

15 WHEREAS, the distinguished women of the Rudder
16 family have made considerable contributions to the development
17 of Rudder Funeral home as well; Mary Anna Rudder, wife of A.G.
18 "Dinky" Rudder established a flower shop near the funeral home
19 when it was located near the old Simpson home; a new flower
20 shop was built behind the funeral home when it relocated to a
21 new facility in 1975; and

22 WHEREAS, through the years, the Rudder family has
23 earned widespread admiration and respect for their tireless
24 dedication and exceptional abilities; they have exceeded
25 expectations in providing the community with remarkable
26 service; now therefore,
