3 WHEREAS, in January of Denver's 10th grade year, she experienced a stroke that caused brain damage, a huge setback 4 5 for an active young woman; she had to relearn many activities and tasks that are often taken for granted, including walking, 6 7 talking, brushing her teeth, feeding and bathing herself; she also experienced loss of short-term memory, the inability to 8 9 read and retain new information, and lost her athletic 10 abilities; and

WHEREAS, determined as ever to overcome the effects 11 of her stroke, Denver worked diligently in therapy and in 12 13 careful coordination with her doctors and by the beginning of the next school year she was able to return full-time to 14 school; by her senior year she was not only playing 15 volleyball, basketball, and softball, but was the captain of 16 17 the cheerleading squad and the varsity volleyball and softball 18 teams, as well as president of the student council and her school's chapter of the Fellowship for Christian Athletes; 19 20 academically she has risen to the occasion and is ranked 6th 21 in her senior class of 50 students; and

22 WHEREAS, Denver's will to live and determination to 23 overcome her obstacles in such extraordinary circumstances 24 have been inspiring to all of those who know Denver; she plans 25 to attend college and pursue a career as a neonatal nurse; and

26 WHEREAS, a worthy role model for countless young
27 Alabamians, Denver espouses the meritorious characteristics of

the Young Heroes Program, and she is truly deserving of
special commendation and praise; now therefore,
