27	manned a mortar position in the midst of intense enemy fire,

carried wounded comrades to safety, and demonstrated numerous other valiant acts; he finally led his group of soldiers in evading the enemy until their rescue by helicopter on March 12, 1966; estimations reveal he eliminated between 135 and 175 soldiers of the enemy and incurred 18 different wounds; and
