8 SYNOPSIS: Currently, Amendment 803 of the Constitution  
9 of Alabama of 1901, as amended, repealed Amendment  
10 709 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now  
11 appearing as Section 260.01 of the Official  
12 Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of  
13 1901, as amended, and reestablished the Education  
14 Trust Fund Rainy Day Account and created the  
15 General Fund Rainy Day Account within the Alabama  
16 Trust Fund.

17 This bill would propose an amendment to the  
18 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, to  
19 repeal Amendment 709 of the Constitution of Alabama  
20 of 1901, now appearing as Section 260.01 of the  
21 Official Recompilation of the Constitution of  
22 Alabama of 1901, as amended, and Amendment 803 of  
23 the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended.

26 TO BE ENTITLED

2 To propose an amendment to the Constitution of  
3 Alabama of 1901, to repeal Amendment 709 of the Constitution  
4 of Alabama 1901, now appearing as Section 260.01 of the  
5 Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901,  
6 as amended, and Amendment 803 of the Constitution of Alabama  
7 of 1901, as amended, relating to the reestablishment of the  
8 Education Trust Fund Rainy Day Account and creation of the  
9 General Fund Rainy Day Account within the Alabama Trust Fund.  
10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

11 Section 1. The following amendment to the  
12 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, is proposed and  
13 shall become valid as a part thereof when approved by a  
14 majority of the qualified electors voting thereon and in  
15 accordance with Sections 284, 285, and 287 of the Constitution  
16 of Alabama of 1901, as amended:

17 PROPOSED AMENDMENT

18 (a) Amendment 709 of the Constitution of Alabama of  
19 1901, now appearing as Section 260.01 of the Official  
20 Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as  
21 amended, is repealed.

22 (b) Amendment 803 of the Constitution of Alabama of  
23 1901, as amended, is repealed.

24 Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment  
25 shall be held in accordance with Sections 284 and 285 of the  
26 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Sections 284  
27 and 285 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of

1 Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this  
2 state.

3 Section 3. The appropriate election official shall  
4 assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional  
5 amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the  
6 following description of the substance or subject matter of  
7 the proposed constitutional amendment:

8 "Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of  
9 Alabama of 1901, to repeal Amendment 709 of the Constitution  
10 of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section 260.01 of the  
11 Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901,  
12 as amended, and Amendment 803 of the Constitution of Alabama  
13 of 1901, as amended, relating to the reestablishment of the  
14 Education Trust Fund Rainy Day Account and creation of the  
15 General Fund Rainy Day Account within the Alabama Trust Fund.
