BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, is proposed and shall become valid as a part thereof when approved by a majority of the qualified electors voting thereon and in accordance with Sections 284, 285, and 287 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended:

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

- (a) Amendment 709 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section 260.01 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, is repealed.
- (b) Amendment 803 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, is repealed.

Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment shall be held in accordance with Sections 284 and 285 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Sections 284 and 285 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of

Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this 1 2 state. Section 3. The appropriate election official shall 3 assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional 4 amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the 5 6 following description of the substance or subject matter of 7 the proposed constitutional amendment: "Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of 8 Alabama of 1901, to repeal Amendment 709 of the Constitution 9 10 of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section 260.01 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, 11 as amended, and Amendment 803 of the Constitution of Alabama 12 13 of 1901, as amended, relating to the reestablishment of the Education Trust Fund Rainy Day Account and creation of the 14 15 General Fund Rainy Day Account within the Alabama Trust Fund.
