11	Section 1. Pursuant to the Alabama Sunset Law, the
12	Sunset Committee recommends the continuance of the State
13	Pilotage Commission until October 1, 2020, with the additional
14	recommendation for statutory change as set out in Section 3.
15	Section 2. The existence and functioning of the
16	State Pilotage Commission, created and functioning pursuant to
17	Sections 33-4-1 to 33-4-57, inclusive, Code of Alabama 1975,
18	is continued until October 1, 2020, and those code sections
19	are expressly preserved.
20	Section 3. Section 33-4-1 of the Code of Alabama
21	1975, is amended to read as follows:
22	" §33-4-1.
23	"(a) There shall be a board of pilotage
24	commissioners, to be known as the State Pilotage Commission,
25	which shall consist of three voting members, one to . One

1	voting member shall be an official of a steamship company
2	which maintains an office in Mobile, one to voting member
3	shall be an active bar pilot, licensed and branched by such
4	the State Pilotage Commission, and one to voting member shall
